Existing Control Measures
1. PPE - Eye/face protection: Safety glasses are not normally required. However, their use is recommended in those cases where splashes may occur when handling the product (EN 166). Hand protection, Body protection, Respiratory protection: No special requirements under normal use conditions.
2. First aid 1. Inhalation: Get medical attention or advice if you feel unwell
3. First aid 2. Skin contact: Wash skin with plenty of lukewarm, gently flowing water. If skin irritation occurs: Get medical advice or attention
4. First aid 3. Eye contact: Hold eyelids apart and flush eyes with plenty of lukewarm water for at least 15 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing. If irritation occurs and persists, get medical attention.
5. First aid 4. Ingestion: Rinse mouth. Immediately drink 1 glass of water. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Get medical attention or advice if you feel unwell.
6. First aid 5. Inhalation: No known effects or symptoms in normal use. Skin contact: No known effects or symptoms in normal use. Eye contact: Causes severe irritation. Ingestion: No known effects or symptoms in normal use

7. Firefighting method - Carbon dioxide. Dry powder. Water spray jet. Fight larger fires with water spray jet or alcohol-resistant foam

8. Cleaning chemicals are not mixed. All staff to Follow instructions on container / packaging

9. COSHH assessments communicated to all relevant staff and SDS read and understood

10. All employees receive induction training upon commencement with the Company

11. Products to be kept in containers have their caps/lids in place and secure when not in use to prevent spillages
