Do not throw any refuse bags over your shoulder. Hold away from your body. Bundle cardboard packaging and recycle where possible. Beware of any hazardous waste. Remove accumulated waste to appropriate collection container/skip and obtain help or use lifting gear when handling heavy wastes. <div style="text-align: center;">  </div> Clean surrounding area and waste bins when emptied. Report any signs of infestation. Sweep area of any remaining small bits of litter and remove with long handled dustpan and broom. Clean and sanitise cleaning equipment etc and remove from site Remove warning signs when safe to do so.
