Hazard: Hazardous Substances Burns and skin irritation caused by exposure to cleaning / polishing chemicals.

#### **Control Measures:**

- 1. An up to date inventory of chemicals is held and includes the hazardous substances used during the stripping and re-sealing of hard flooring.
- 2. Safety Data Sheets are obtained from suppliers along with relevant COSHH Risk Assessments undertaken.
- 3. Dilution rates are followed.
- 4. Adequate natural ventilation is provided when conducting this activity.
- 5. All waste is disposed of in line with the manufacturer's instructions.
- 6. Staff have received hazardous substance awareness training.
- 7. Appropriate PPE is provided and worn.

Hazard: Working at Height Falls from height when working incorrectly on the stairs. (Falling over the handrail)

### **Control Measures:**

- 1. Operative are aware of the potential of falls from height when working on staircases.
- 2. Safe working zones are established prior to the commencement of the activity.
- 3. Operatives visually check and monitor for others approaching the work area.
- 4. Access to stairs is restricted when work is being carried out.

Hazard: Manual Handling Sprains, strains and other musculoskeletal injuries from incorrect manual handling techniques.

#### **Control Measures:**

- 1. All operative have received Manual Handling Training, which includes the lifting, moving carrying of work equipment and conducting the work activity.
- 2. Team lifting is utilised wherever possible.
- 3. Employees must only move loads that are within their own capabilities.
- 4. Where possible heavy, large or awkward loads are broken down into smaller more manageable loads.



- 5. Employees are provided with suitable protective, non-slip footwear.
- 6. Manual handling aids i.e. trollies are used to transfer equipment.

# Hazard: Work Equipment Cuts / bruising from contact with scrubbing machines, Vacuum cleaner etc.

#### **Control Measures:**

- 1. All work equipment is suitable and sufficient for the work activity.
- 2. The work equipment used is inspected and maintained in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions.
- 3. Only CE marked equipment is purchased and used. The work equipment includes; vacuum cleaners and scrubbing machines.
- 4. Job rotation and frequent breaks are conducted to prevent fatigue, manual handling and vibration ill health effects. Where there is a possibility of ill health effects caused by noise or vibration exposure separate risk assessments will be undertaken.
- 5. All portable electrical appliances are subject to a portable appliance test conducted by a competent person.
- 6. An inventory is held with appropriate signage displayed on each individual piece of portable electrical equipment.
- 7. If necessary, a plug circuit breaker (incorporating an RCD) is used to provide additional electrical safety

## Hazard: Hazardous Substances Harm to self or others if products are not used correctly

## **Control Measures:**

- 1. Cleaning chemicals are not mixed. All staff to Follow instructions on container / packaging
- 2. Products to be kept in containers have their caps/lids in place and secure when not in use to prevent spillages
- 3. COSHH assessments communicated to all relevant staff and SDS read and understood
- 4. All employees receive induction training upon commencement with the Company
